The forest conservation act was enacted by the Indian Parliament in 1980. According to its rules, the indiscriminate cutting of trees in forests, is a punishable offence. Many areas in India have been converted into National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries to protect the forest cover and the animals that live in the forests. A national park is a reserved land usually declared and owned by the national government . It is a protected from most human developments and pollution. A sactuary is also a reserved area in which birds and animals are protected from hunting. A national park differs from a sanctuary in that no human activity is allowed inside the former , while limited actvities are permitted within the latter. National parks receive more finacial support from the Central Government. The Gir National park in Gujrat is probably the only place in the world where the Asiatic lion is protected so that it can live in its natural surroundings .

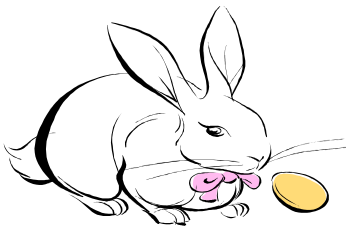
