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Dear parents,

According to CBSE & DAV curriculum- 2025-26, the assessment structure and examination in our school is explained below:

## Nursery-II:

The complete session will be divided into three terms-First ending in August, 2<sup>nd</sup> ending in December & 3<sup>rd</sup> ending in March. The assessment of three terms will be done in August, December & March respectively in the form of oral tests, written tests & assignments. The syllabus for all terms is available on school app and school website ([davfatehabad.in](http://davfatehabad.in))

## III-VII

For classes III to VII, there will be two terms in an academic year. Syllabus weightage of each term is given below:

Classes 3,4 & 5	Term1-50%syllabus Term2-50%syllabus
Class 6	Term1-50%syllabus Term2-50%syllabus+30% syllabus of Term1(topics relevant for the next grade)*
Class 7	Term1-50%syllabus Term2-50%syllabus+40% syllabus of Term1(topics relevant for the next grade)*

\*Syllabus will be notified through student diary/school app.

Assessment will be done in two ways and carry the below-mentioned weightage in each term:

- **PEN PAPER TESTS (P.P.T.)-70%**
- **INTERNAL ASSESSMENT(I.A.)-30%**

There will be two pen-paper tests in each term.

- **Term1-Unit Test1(20Marks)**
- **Half Yearly Exam(50 Marks for III- V & 80 Marks for VI-VII)**
- **Term2-Unit Test 2(20 Marks)**
- **Annual Exam(50 Marks for III- V & 80 Marks for VI-VII)**

Internal assessment comprises of subject enrichment activities such as notebooks, assignments, holidays homework, portfolio, reading skills, writing skills, activities, projects etc. In languages, there will be 4 bonus marks for good readers based on the books assigned for reading by the teacher.

**Grading criteria for Class X Board Exams**

The Board Examination in each subject will cover entire syllabus of Class-X. Grades corresponding to the marks shall be on the basis of 9-point grading system. Grades will be awarded in each scholastic subject. For awarding the grades, the Board will put all the passed students in a rank order and will award the grades as follows:

A-1	Top 1/8th of the passed candidates
A-2	Next 1/8th of the passed candidates
B-1	Next 1/8th of the passed candidates
B-2	Next 1/8th of the passed candidates
C-1	Next 1/8th of the passed candidates
C-2	Next 1/8th of the passed candidates
D-1	Next 1/8th of the passed candidates
D-2	Next 1/8th of the passed candidates
E*	Essential Repeat

**Passing Criteria:**

A student will be required to get minimum 'D' grade (or 33% marks) in each subject in Annual Comprehensive Result (III-VII)/ Annual Exam (VIII onwards) to get promotion to next class. The students placed in 'E' grade in any subject will be given only one chance to improve their performance to get minimum 'D' grade to pass.

Note: 1. The students getting overall 90% or above marks will be awarded at the end of session.  
 2. Students will be selected for Super-40 sections (VII onwards) w.e.f. session 2026-27 on the basis of 'Qualifier Exam' to be organized in April-2026.
