Dear parents,

As you are aware, the CBSE has issued Circular No. Acad-05/2017 dated 31.01.2017 on the restoration of Board Examination for class X and revised assessment structure and examination for class X from Academic Year 2017-18 onwards. To increase the confidence in the students to start preparing for class X Board examination when they join the upper primary stage in class VI, the CBSE has decided to implement the uniform system of assessment, examination pattern and issue of report cards for classes VI to VIII also on the similar pattern. In this regard the assessment structure and examination in our school for classes VI to X will comprise of two terms i.e. Term-1 and 2 as explained below:

i) Scholastic Area:

Note: The students placed in 'E' grade will be given only one chance to improve their performance to get minimum 'D' grade to pass.

ii) Co-Scholastic Activities: For the holistic development of the student, co-curricular activities in the following areas will be carried out and will be graded term-wise on a 3-point grading scale (A=Outstanding, B=Very Good and C=Fair). The aspect of regularity, sincere participation, output and teamwork will be the generic criteria for grading in the following co-scholastic activities:

- (a) Work Education - Work Education refers to skill-based activities resulting in goods or services useful to the community
- (b) Art Education (Visual & Performing Art)
- (c) Health and Physical Education (Sports/Martial Arts/Yoga/NCC etc.)

iii) Discipline: The students will also be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behaviour, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others. Grading on Discipline will be done term-wise on a 3-point grading scale (A=Outstanding, B=Very Good and C=Fair)
