# Introduction



## Management for Excellence

**M**aharishi Dayanand Saraswati rose on the Indian horizon when India was passing through the era of superstitions, social evils, illiteracy, ignorance and slavery. He promised his Guru Swami Virjanand that he would spread the light of the Vedas throughout the length and breadth of the country. As a true patriot, in his acclaimed work Satyarth Prakash, he enunciated the doctrine of India's independence by talking about Swaraj and Swadeshi. After the death of Swamiji on October 30, 1883 his followers decided that an Educational Institution would be the best memorial in the honour of their mentor.

The first D.A.V. School was opened on Tuesday, June 1, 1886 with Sh. Hans Raj as Head Master (now known as Mahatma Hans Raj). Dayanand Anglo Vedic College Trust and Management Society got registered on August 17, 1886 with the objectives of teaching and learning of :

- a) Hindi Literature
- b) Classical Sanskrit of the Vedas
- c) English literature for the study of Science and Technology (both theoretical and applied)

The society today runs more than 700 institutions in India and abroad which include Schools, Colleges, Technical Institutes, Research Centres, Medical Colleges, Schools for weaker sections, Centres for mentally and physically handicapped children, Old age Homes and Orphanages.

## Educational Set-up

The school is a senior secondary school affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi. Our academic planning and programmes are designed keeping in view the new education policy. The syllabus prescribed is the one recommended by NCERT, New Delhi. The medium of instruction is English but equal stress is laid on Hindi & Sanskrit. The classroom in our school is no longer a dull place with a monotonous routine in which the child is at the receiving end, the teacher at the giving end. On the other hand the classroom vibrates with vigour and vitality where the teacher employs activity oriented methods and makes use of the other audio-visual aids like Tape-recorder, TV, VCR, LCD Projector and Computer etc. for enhancing the knowledge of the students.

## Library

The school has a well-stocked library with more than 12000 books including the text-books, encyclopedias, reference material, literature, audio & video cassettes as well as CDs. The library is continuously updated to expose the students to modern trends and concepts of education. Besides the books, the library also subscribes to journals and magazines. It is also equipped with latest editions of publication, handbooks on various subjects, encyclopedia and e-library.





## Computer Lab

The school provides the necessary latest hardware and software infrastructure to cater to the computing needs of all the students and staff and the training needs of information technology related courses. The school is equipped with 2 Labs with more than 50 computers. All the systems are equipped with necessary software and latest configuration. An Internet connection assets the students in their continuous search for knowledge through the Wi-fi Broad Band connectivity.



## Art and Craft Room

The school has a separate 'Art Room' where creativity of students is nurtured with necessary accouterments to sensitize their aesthetic qualities.





## Science Laboratories

To ensure an ambience for innovative & creative pedagogy, the theory classes are supplemented with practical knowledge. The school possesses the most advanced Physics, Chemistry and Biology labs equipped with necessary apparatus and infrastructure to facilitate the students to learn through experiments and activities.



## Canteen

The school facilitates a 'Canteen' to refresh the students with various kinds of eatables. It provides healthy & hygienic eatables during recess period.



## First-Aid Room & Other Facilities

The school has a Medical Room for students in case of any emergency. Besides this, their health and fitness is annually checked by medical experts. To provide hygienic conditions to students, many water-coolers with Aqua Guards have been made available in the school premises that provide filtered water. To provide continuous supply of electricity, generators have been provided.

Hot Case facility has been provided in class rooms to provide warm food.

It is a matter of sheer pleasure that many students are selected in engineering and medical colleges every year. ## School Conveyance

## Music and Dance Room

## Modern Methods of Teaching

We realise that the field of education is going through a total metamorphosis and life today has undergone a radical change. We follow the innovative methods instead of traditional methods of teaching. Most of teaching is done by the method of learning by doing. Play-way methods are adopted in pre-primary and in middle classes, audio-visual aids and other transitional methods are adopted. Teachers are sent for attending various seminars and orientation programmes. The introduction of smart classes has brought a complete transformation in classrooms. It has not only brought abstract and difficult curriculum concepts live inside the classrooms but has also made learning an exuberant experience for students.

## Mathematics Lab

A well equipped mathematics laboratory is the source of attraction for young mathematicians. The students learn practical skills in an interesting manner.

## Clubs

There are three clubs namely Health & Wellness Club, Cyber Club & Eco Club, Music Club, Literary Club and Art Club. It is compulsory for students of secondary classes to opt for membership of any one club & participate actively in club activities which are organized on every last working day of the month.

## Excursion

'Nature is the best Teacher, keeping this in mind we organise educational trips for students. This helps to create a harmony between nature and education and provides them a beautiful change from routine life.



## Sports

In tune with the objective of all round development of students, the school also encourages various sporting and physical development activities amongst students. The school has the privilege of getting good ranks in Athletics among all CBSE affiliated schools in Haryana and school is an achiever of first position in Table Tennis and Soft Ball Tournament at State level. The students are selected to represent at National Level in various games every year. The students enjoy facilities for Basketball, Volleyball, Handball, Softball, Football, Table Tennis, Lawn Tennis, Badminton, Cricket, Skating, Chess, Carom, Athletics and many more.





## Co-curricular & Extra-curricular Activities

Co-curricular activities form an integral part of daily routine of our students. Music, drama, debate, quiz, dance, art and craft have been the regular features of the school to develop aesthetic sense, creativity and emotional harmony. The department of Extra-curricular activities remains active throughout the year in organizing various competitions. To develop a sense of healthy competition, the school is divided into five houses i.e. Jagriti House, Kranti House, Pragati House, Shakti House and Sanskriti House. All the houses actively involve themselves in the smooth and systematic functioning of school.

## Parents-Teachers Meeting

On the last working day of every month, the parents-teachers meeting is held to discuss the performance of their wards. The parents are not allowed at all to enter into the classroom any time according to their own convenience. But they are welcome to school with their problems and suggestions on the last working day of every month at the given time. In addition to it, special meetings of parents with the Principal and the Teachers are also arranged from time to time to discuss the problems of students individually and ways are thought out for their solution.



## Examination System

The academic year commences in April and ends in March. The syllabus for classes from UKG to V is divided into three semesters - first ending in August, second ending in November and third ending in March. The Annual result is declared on the basis of performance in all the three semesters. The Annual Examinations from class U.K.G. to VII are held in the first week of March. Public Examination for classes VIII & XI conducted by D.A.V. Education Board, New Delhi, are held in the month of February/March and for classes IX, X & XII conducted by C.B.S.E. New Delhi, are held in the month of March. No student is issued admit card in class XII who keeps himself/herself absent in Pre-Board Exams.



## Attendance

Normally students must attend the school daily. In case of any exigency a student can proceed on leave with prior sanctioning of leave. The leave application without signature of parents / guardians will not be entertained.

If a student remains absent (without sanction of leave) for more than seven consecutive days, his/her name may be struck off from the school. If the total attendance is less than 80% for class Pre-Nursery to VIII & 75% for class IX to XII the student will not be permitted to take the annual examination.

A fine of ₹ 2/- will be charged from the students of class III to X who remain absent without prior permission and ₹ 5/- from students of XI & XII per day.

Leave application for one to three days is sanctioned by the class teacher, only when they are supported by required documents (Medical certificate etc.) or statement by the parents and leave application for more than three days is sanctioned by the Principal.

## Promotion Criteria

The School has its own promotion schemes with regards to the promotion of a student to the next higher class. Promotion of students to higher classes depends on regularity in school attendance, over-all performance in final exams and also during the year, taking into account the weightage of marks obtained by the students in successive tests, exams and periodicals, opinion of the teachers with regard to the conduct and discipline of the students and his/her regularity in home work and assignments. A student is normally required to secure 35% marks in individual subject and 40% in aggregate for promotion to next class. Upto class X, a child is required to get minimum D grade in every subject. Only one chance is provided to students placed in compartment to clear the subject in which he/she has got less than D grade.



## Scholarship

In order to encourage meritorious students the school honours those students who secure above 90% marks in aggregate in board classes and have stood first in their respective classes. In addition to this the school awards trophies on Annual Day to the students for being best in debate & cultural activities, best athlete, best players in sports, best students for uniform and cleanliness, maximum attendance, best in discipline and students in A+ and A category in their respective classes.

Stipends and free ships are provided to intelligent deserving students from economically weaker section of society.

## Registration & Admission

1. Registration form given alongwith the prospectus must be filled in with blue ink and submitted in the school office within the specified dates/time alongwith the required documents.
2. Admission Fee once submitted will not be refunded except in case of transfer of parents on submission of transfer letter by competent authority.
3. Admission to Pre-Nursery is given on Interview basis. Minimum Eligible Age for Pre-Nursery is 2½ years as on 1st April. Birth Certificate issued by Municipal corporation & a passport size photograph are essential with the application form.
4. Admission from classes L.K.G. to VIII will be considered on merit basis and interaction with parents and child, subject to availability of seats. Transfer certificate, a passport size photograph & attested copy of report card are essential with the registration form.
5. Admission to class IX & XI is done only on the basis of their results in matric/admission test and interview and subject to availability of the seats. Original character certificate, original transfer certificate, attested copy of migration certificate (if from other than CBSE Board) & a passport size photograph are essential with the application form. Admission test for IX & XI will be based on NCERT books of previous class.
6. Transfer certificate issued by schools affiliated to Board other than CBSE, will be considered only when duly attested by District Education officer.
7. Generally subjects can be changed within a week after the date of admission, but in special case, subject can be changed within a month with the prior permission of the Principal.
8. As a policy matter, no admission is made to classes X & XII.
9. Admission to class XI is provisional and is finalized after the declaration of the Board result.
10. Registration for admission in any case does not guarantee admission.
11. Registration fee is non-refundable.

## Forms of Disciplinary Measures

- i) The Following disciplinary measures may be adopted by the school in dealing with erring student who indulge in any act of indiscipline.
- BLUE CARD** Blue card will be issued for violation of any rule.
  - YELLOW CARD** Repetition of the offense would incur the penalty of suspension indicated by issue of yellow card.
  - RED CARD** Red card would result in rustication of the student from the school.
- ii) The Principal of the school who is satisfied that a pupil has indulged in any of the forbidden practices may warn or impose fine or expel the pupil under intimation to his parents or guardian.

## Withdrawal from School

Generally a student may be withdrawn from the school at the end of the academic session. A notice for such withdrawal must be submitted to the Principal before 15th March. In such cases, a transfer certificate will be issued to the student on 31st March after clearing all the dues. However, if a student is to be withdrawn in the middle of the academic year due to some unavoidable circumstances the parents are required to give one month notice/one month tuition fee except in transfer cases. In such cases the transfer certificate will be issued after clearing all the dues.
